

What are Club Colours?

Club Colours are awarded as recognition of your service to your Sports Club and #TeamGlos during your time at UoG.

The University of Gloucestershire Students' Union award Club Colours to recognise the invaluable work of students who have made outstanding contributions to the sport, running, operation, and activity of a UoG Club. Every attempt has been made to standardise the level of colours awards recognising that standard with and across clubs may vary.

Full Colours are awarded as recognition of high-level performance in your field of sport at national or international level, and/or your TeamGlos Sports Club during your time at UoG.

Colours are given to students who are in their final year of study.

Who can be awarded Colours?

Any student can be nominated for Colours from any club affiliated to the Students' Union, as long as they are a full member of the Students' Union. Individuals must compete in the name of the University of Gloucestershire and must play for their SU Club. The committee must be selective on all nominations and only put forward those who they feel deserve a Colours award, as per the criteria.

Although an individual may meet the criteria it is the discretion of the SU Activities Team to decide who is awarded a Colours award and students will not automatically receive Colours if they have reached the required standards.

All Colours are awarded at the Students' Union Awards evening. If someone is not able to attend the awards evening, they will be able to contact us to collect their award from the SU at another time.

CLUB COLOURS CRITERIA

In order to be awarded Full Colours, a student must meet the mandatory 2 criteria below in **BOLD** for Full Colours, as well as a minimum of 3 or more from the Full Colours criteria.

In order to be awarded Half Colours, a student must meet the mandatory 1 criteria in **BOLD**, as well as a minimum of 4 or more from the Half Colours criteria below.

Full Colours (Must meet the mandatory 2, + 3 or more criteria from the Full Colours criteria)

- A student who's finishing their studies this academic year (mandatory)
- A student who has been a part of their sports club for 3+ years of university (mandatory)
- Been a committee member for at least 2+ years
- Represented their clubs' First Team for 2+ years of university
- Consistently high level of performance in their field of sport e.g Representing their sport at national or international level
- Have they contributed to the development of the club through coaching, exceptional leadership etc. (Any additional examples must be explained in the nominations form)

Half Colours (Must meet the mandatory 1, + 4 or more from the Half Colours criteria)

- A student who's finishing their studies this academic year (mandatory)
- Been a committee member for at least 1 year
- A student who has been a part of their sports club for 2+ years of university
- Represented any of their clubs' teams for a full 2+ years
- Maintained a professional attitude and have been an asset to TeamGlos
- Made contributions to the development & successes of their club. For example, have they lead on any fundraisers, outreach projects or events for the club? Have they contributed to the development of the club through coaching, exceptional leadership etc. (Any additional examples must be explained in the nominations form)
