Motion Summary	Reinstatement of Helpzones, Libraries, Direct IT-Support and other student support services to Park as the current arrangement has been detrimental to students trying to access help and support. The Students Union also believe that the Uni is wasting money on student study-areas while the current ones are underused. As most students prefer to study at home or in their rooms, there are no incentives to have study groups on campus. The Students Union believe that this is a waste of resources that could he put to better use in improving facilities.
Union Notes	 The demonstratable facts are as presented: Students of the Uni, have no immediate access to support on campus when needed. Students must use their own money and time to travel from Park to Francis Close Hall and back. Current student study spaces are not being use regularly enough to justify the installation of more spaces.

That students are suffering in silence without contact support, because they feel they do not have the money, time or ability to commute across Cheltenham in order access the facilities needed. Some of the spaces that were used as help zone or library are now sitting empty and those who are converted to study spaces are
